



10 HOUR TRAINING



Did you know?

Under the law, HB-5537, all employees performing manual labor on state, municipal building construction or repair contracts as well as any public works project, including sewage & water treatment plants, site work, road and bridge work, parking lots and drainage systems contracts of \$100,000 or more must prove they have completed a 10-hour construction safety and health course that meets federal OSHA Training Institute standards. Also, instead of applying the training requirement to all projects of \$100,000 or more, the bill applies the existing prevailing wage project thresholds to the training requirement. This means the requirement kicks in for (1) repair and renovation projects of \$100,000 or more and (2) new construction projects of \$400,000 or more. The bill also creates training requirement exceptions for employees of public service companies and commercial vehicle drivers who either pick up at or deliver cargo to public work projects.

The IEC-NE course will meet all of your OSHA training needs and you will receive your OSHA certification. The courses are held at IEC-NE Headquarters, 1800 Silas Deane Hwy, Rocky Hill.
