- A mandatory orientation for new and transfer students is scheduled for Wednesday, August 21, 2024 at 5:30 pm.
- Classes begin for returning students on Monday, August 26th OR Tuesday, August 27th 2023 at 5:30 pm.
- Classes are held on Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday evenings, 5:30–8:30 pm at IEC New England, 273 Dividend Road, Suite A, Rocky Hill, CT.
- All transfer students must provide transcripts, take a math assessment and/or test out prior to entering the program.

Tuition: Tuition does not include books/materials (see other side for all related fees).

Book orders: MUST accompany registration:

- Books are purchased prior to the start of school for use during the entire year; some are used for multiple years.
- 6.35% sales tax and shipping & handling charges is included in the cost of books.
- Books will be available at the orientation for 1st year and transfer students and the 1st night of class at the school (unless on backorder).
